We're seeking submissions for the Fall 2012 issue. Please send:

- fashion sketches and technical schematics (for garments)
- swatch of proposed stitch in desired yarn weight and fiber (color is important).
- a written description of the piece and its construction, technical details, decorative details.
- your mailing address, phone number, and email address
- submission form

THEMES:

Zippered: Use zippers for closure and for design element. Close a pocket with a zip, or the cowlneck of a pullover. Use a zip along a raglan placket, the back of the neck, the cuff, or straight down the front like always. Silhouettes and stitches should be simple but interesting. The look is strong, minimal and tough, leather accessories, camel and cream and charcoal and plum.

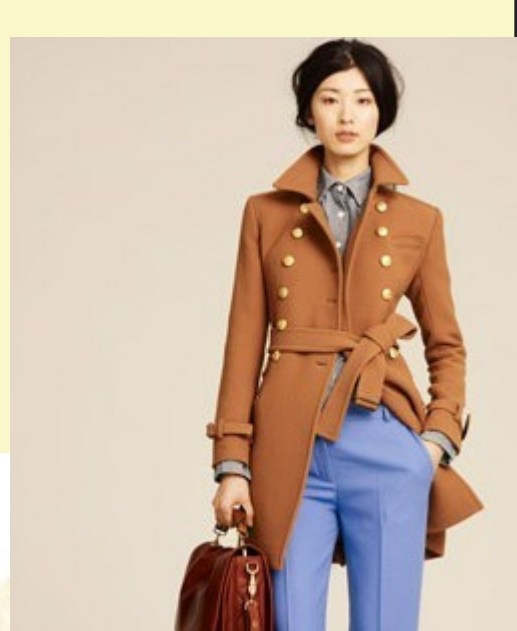
Yarn Dreams. Imbue your knits with whimsy. Accessories and garments move in a fantastical direction, while remaining wearable and simple to knit. Boucle, mohair, silk blends meet with big stitches, pictorial lace motifs, belled shapes, fringe, funnel necks. Think of mitts, socks, hats, cowls, oversized sweaters. Keep it contemporary. Feminine and strong. Our ingénue may be gentle looking, but she can be dangerous.

Back by December. Classic outerwear with heritage and offbeat touches. Structured jackets, Aran-inspired pullovers, trim little hats and mitts, tweedy shawls, knee-high socks with rib and twisted stitches. Toggles and shawl colors meet the unexpected—a biased stripe, an intarsia fox, contrast-color I-cord edgings. Bring some playfulness and youthfulness to this classic, mature theme.
